It have been a great experience, that I recommend to everyone, and I'll for sure do it again, in an other country.



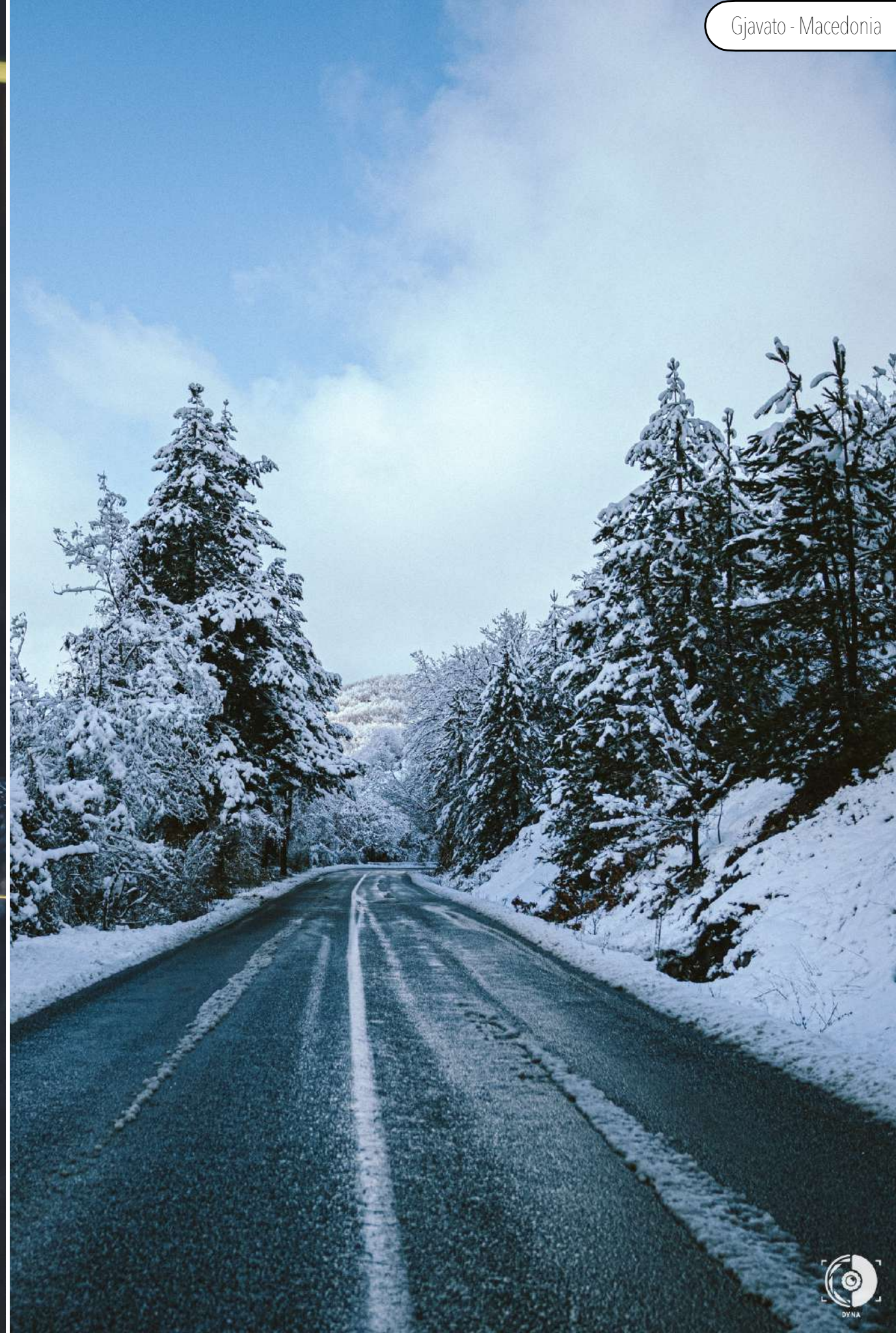

Tirana - Albania

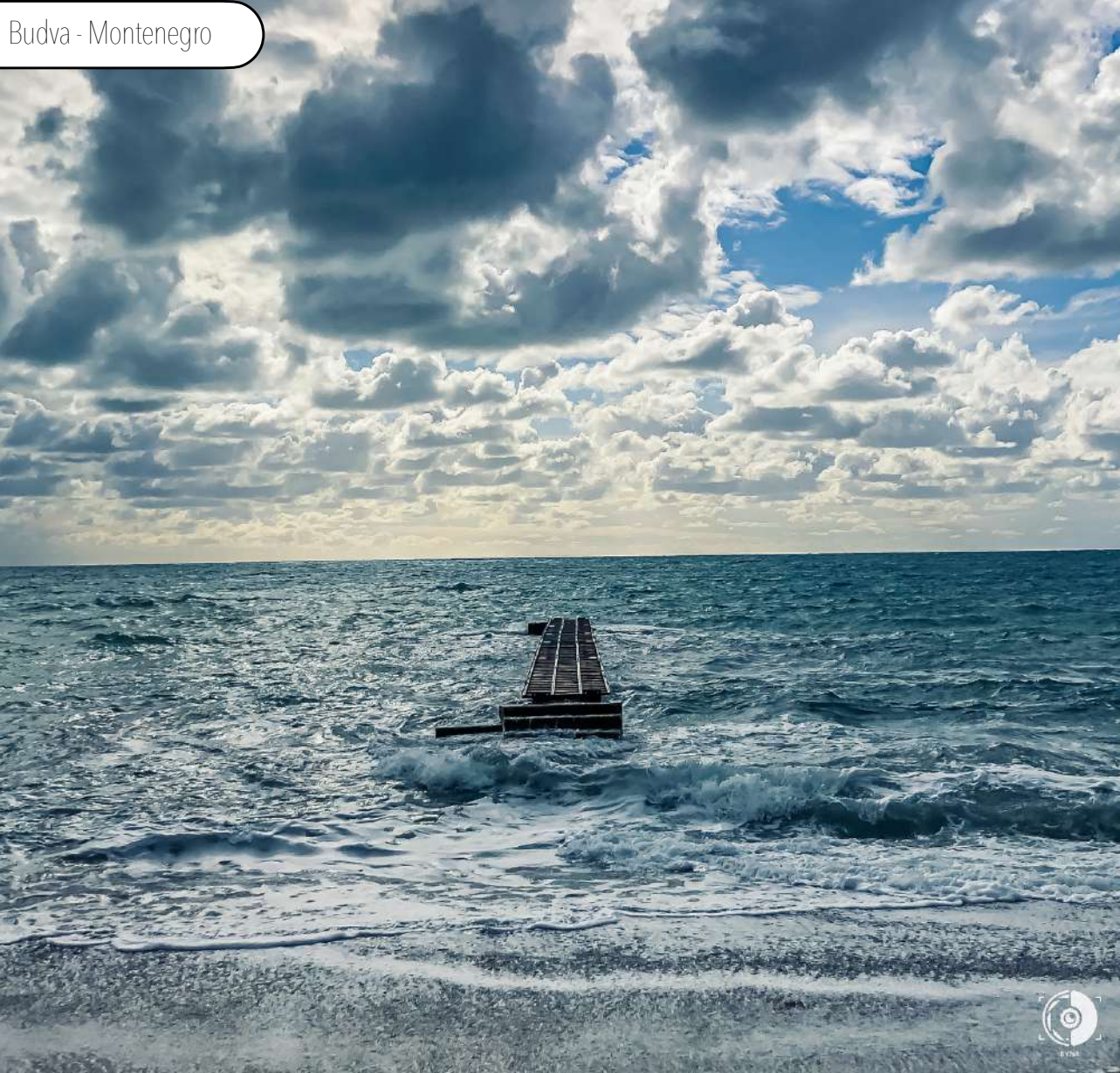




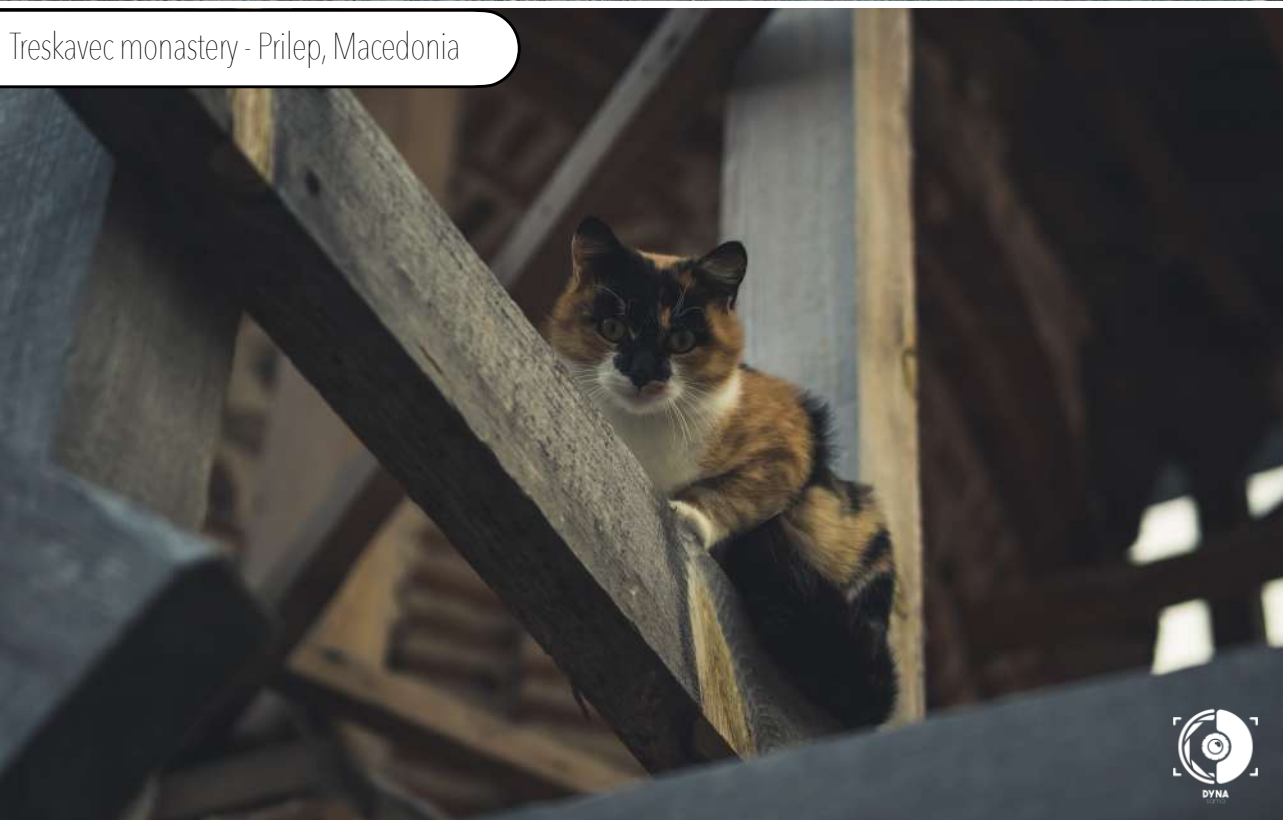
