I have been in Macedonia for 2 weeks now and I haven't had much culture shock even though everyday life is different than in France. On this second newslatter I will show you the difference between France and Macedonia.

The difference between France and Macedonia

The first difference that "shocked" me was the price. In Macedonia everything is 2 or 3 times cheaper than in France and that is a big plus for us.



For example, a bottle of coke in France is the equivalent of 100 Macedonian denars.



When I arrived on the first night we went to the kebab down our street and it cost us only 100 MKD. In France it is 4.5 €, the equivalent of 275 MKD.



It's pretty cliché, but it's about it, on the left we had Paris, France and on the right we had Macedonia. In Macedonia it is more landscaped than in France. (even if in the South of France we had very beautiful views)



Trade in France



The biggest difference between France and Macedonia are the shops. Everything is smaller in Prilep, the supermarkets, the clothes shops, by the way, all the shops. The average sales area in stores in France is 240m2 while in Macedonia it is 5x smaller
